6. Visitors / Speakers to address the Board:
 - A. La Crescent Animal Rescue: Keith Petras here from LAR to address dangerous dog retrieval. Brought in an agent to speak tonight, who is under contract with Houston, Caledonia, Spring Grove, Brownsville and Hokah. (Sorry, I THINK her name is Marcie Jensen) She is paid annually by each community she contracts with. She is working with Sheriff Inglet to pick-up high-risk animals in the County. Brought a copy of her homeowners but not her \$2 million liability copy. She will bring that to the next Town Board meeting in April. Keith Petras closed with a reiteration that any township resident who surrenders an animal will not be billed to the township. The only time they will charge the township is when one is rescued in our boundry and then after a 5 day reclaim period. The charge is \$125 per animal with \$25 going to the City. Liability insurance is in effect for 1 year from the date of signing and then renewable annually. Carla Ronneberg asked if the contact could be signed at the next meeting. Chairman Cummings responded that if it in front of the Board before that, they will vote on whether to move forward.
 - B. Jim Hobelsberger (2852 Kelly Rd) presented a petition from 15 residents on Kelly Rd to have the sand removed from their road. Chairman Cummings advised we will remove it, but only after snow chances are less likely.
 - C. Jeremy Chipps asked why public is not invited to the Planning Commission meetings as we are changing the Ordinances. Bob said that

Planning Commission IS a public meeting that is posted. Furthermore, the public will be invited to the final presentation of the Ordinance changes as well.

D. Ken Tshumper wanted to express concerns over the Mathy Mine project. Regulation of mining is difficult and the County provides good oversight. Encouraged the Board to contract with the County for this process.

E. Gretchen Cook 517 N 3rd St. expressed concern over abandoned mines in Trempealeau Co WI.

F. Andrew Peters and Tony Tomczyk from Milestone Products presented a map of the excavation site they hold off County 25. Their purpose tonight is informational but may seek a C.U.P. in the future to re-open that mine
